I understand that this information will be used, in part, to determine my eligibility for a volunteer position. I also understand that as long as I remain a volunteer, this information may be checked again at any time. I understand that I will have an opportunity to review the criminal history and, if I dispute the record as received, a procedure is available for clarification.

2012 Counselor Rules

1. No Smoking/Drugs/Sex, etc. Shouldn't have to say this.
2. Stay in Camp for the Duration
3. Stay in cabin with campers from 9:45 pm to 6:00 am.
4. In case of emergency, be sure your cabin is covered with an Assistant Counselor during your absence.
5. If emergency arises, you have to be away from your cabin BE SURE BOB AND ASST DIRECTOR KNOW WHERE YOU ARE!
6. Be on Time!!! (5 minutes early)
7. Be in session with campers unless you have a camp duty to perform...or it is your turn for a break or personal time. Remember – every counselor needs an occasional break.
8. No trips to town to buy anything for campers for skits and banners. The cabin will be disqualified if they don't provide their own props.
