MAJOR GRANTS UPDATES

- **Elimination of cash match for global grants**
- **COVID-19 activities no longer eligible under disaster response grants**
- **International sponsor contribution minimum reduced to 15 percent**
- **Low-cost shelters and simple schools discontinued through global grants**
- **Environment added as area of focus**
- **Rotaract clubs will be able to sponsor global grants**

UPDATES CONTINUED

Elimination of a World Fund minimum

Effective immediately, there is no minimum World Fund match for global grants.

For example, under the new policy, grant financing might look like this:

\$10,000 DDF + \$10,000 World Fund + \$10,000 cash contributions = \$30,000 global grant

Or

\$5,000 DDF + \$5,000 World Fund + \$20,000 cash contributions = \$30,000 global grant

UPDATES CONTINUED

Alternative financing when it's needed

We encourage grant sponsors to finance their global grants **without a World Fund match.**

Sponsors can use DDF, cash, directed gifts, or endowment earnings to make up the minimum \$30,000 budget that they need for their grant activity.

UPDATES TO TERMS & CONDITIONS

- **Effective 1 July, the Foundation is no longer matching cash contributions for global grants. (see section VI)**
- **The international sponsor contribution requirement has been changed from 30 to 15 percent (see section VI)**
- **Work restrictions for project beneficiaries clarified (see section III)**

GLOBAL GRANTS THAT ADDRESS COVID-19

- **Must be submitted under DPT Area of Focus**
- **Medical equipment/PPE only is OK**
- **15% international contribution requirement waived**
- **International partner still required**
