- Founded February 23, 1905
  - Paul Harris – Lawyer
  - Gustave Loehr – Engineer & FM
  - Silvester Schiele – Coal Merchant
  - Hiram Shorey – Tailor



# Rotary Milestones

- 1911- Our Motto(s) approved in 1950
  - Service Above Self & He Profits  
Most Who Serves Best
- 1912 – Becomes RI and expands to Europe.
- 1917 RIP Arch Klumph starts RI Foundation with \$26.50



# Rotary Milestones

- 1943 – The Four Way Test adopted
- 1945 – RI joins UN as NGO
- 1947 – Paul Harris dies & Scholar program is born
- 1957 – PHF recognition established
- 1962 – Interact begins



# Rotary Milestones

- 1965 – GSE Begins
- 1968 – Rotaract Begins
- 1971 – RYLA Begins
- 1975 – RYE Becomes Official
- 1978 – 3H grants Begin

- 1979 – Polio Eradication Begins
- 1985 – Polio Plus Launched
- 1989 – Women Join Rotary
- 1999 – Peace Centers Created
- 2004 – AKS created

# District Goals



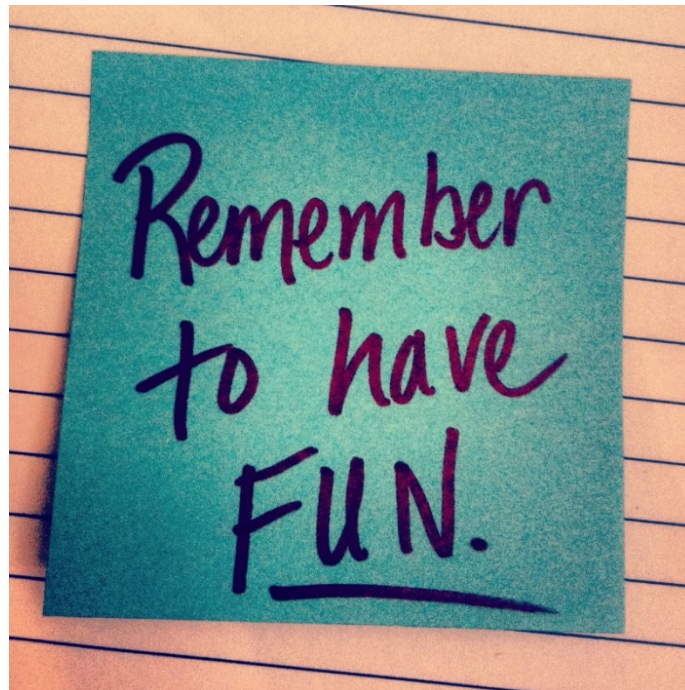
- Every Club net gain 4 members

- Each club send a student to RYLA.

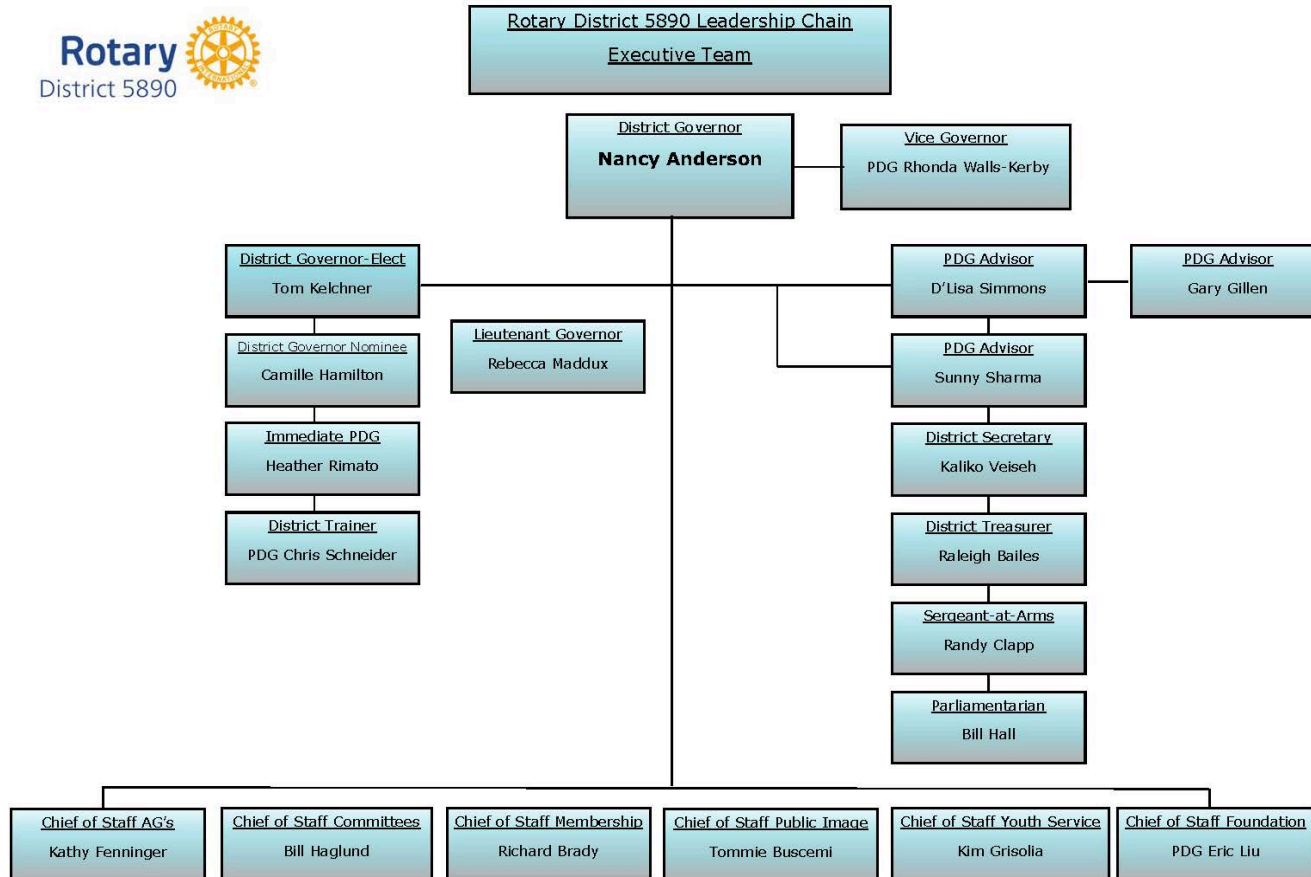


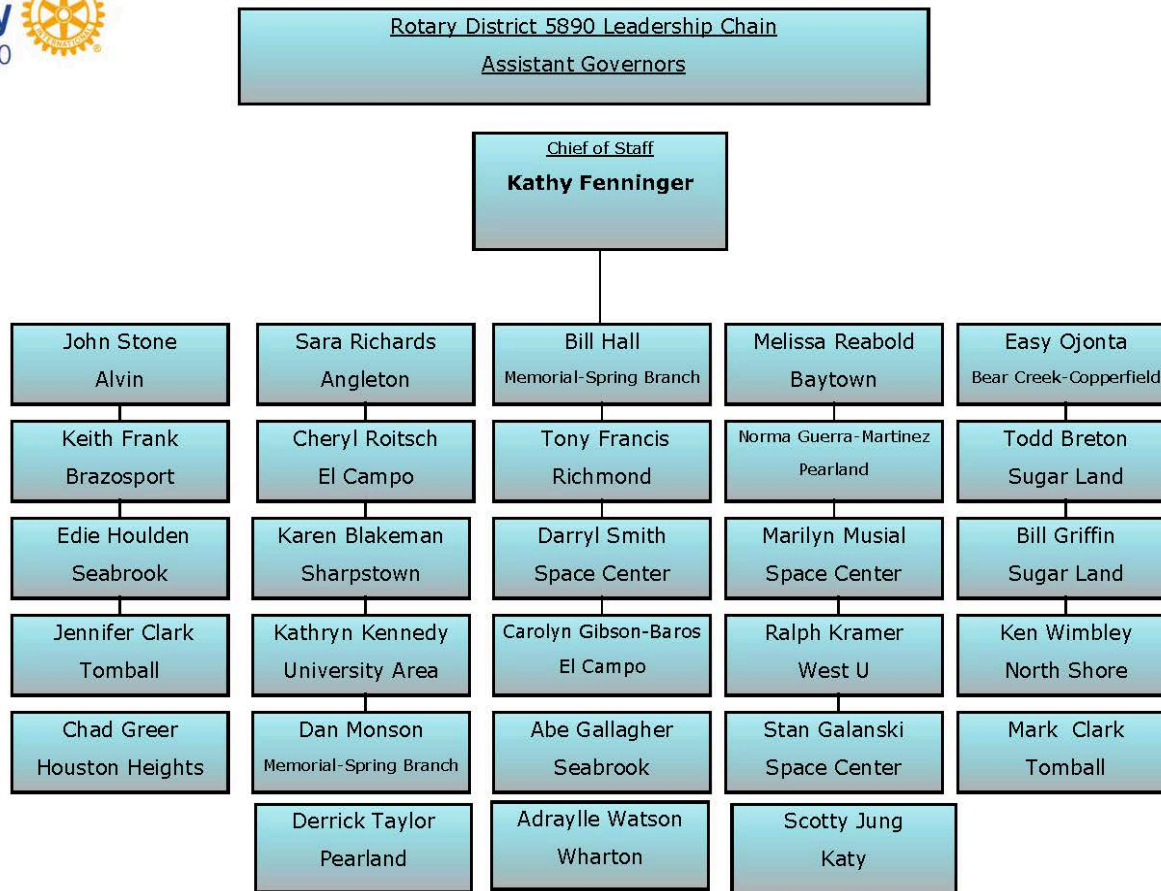
