MODEL RELEASE GUIDELINES




All subjects in Rotary photos must sign a model release. **If Rotary does not recieve your signed model release**, **we cannot use your photo.**

Instructions:


- 1. Each adult subject must fill out and sign the model release before they are photographed or filmed. No one else may sign a release for an adult subject except for themselves. All subjects under the age of 18 or who lack legal capacity must have the release signed by their **parent or legal guardian.**
- 2. A photo must be taken of the subject holding their signed model release. This is done to ensure a clear one-to-one match of the person's name with their model release. See examples below.
- 3. If photo AND video is being captured, subjects appearing in both shoots only need to complete one model release.
