**1. Interact Teacher/Faculty Sponsor of the Year:** (Interact presidents or another club officer are responsible for submitting this form.) The success of an Interact Club rests largely on the efforts of the faculty sponsor(s). This award will recognize the outstanding commitment and motivational skills of the winning faculty sponsor. Nominations should include an essay (between 250 and 500 words) describing the activities of the teacher that entitles him or her for this special recognition. **A cash prize of \$150 will be awarded to the winner.** If there is more than one teacher who sponsors an Interact Club, and both are nominated, or if there is a tie, the prize will be split.

It is up to the Rotary Club Sponsor, however, to extend a hand of cooperation on behalf of his or her Rotary Club, and provide direction to the Interact Club. Nominations for this award are an essay (between 250 and 500 words) describing how the Rotary Club Sponsor provided meaningful assistance to the Interact Club. **A \$100 Paul Harris Fellow donation will be made to the Rotary Foundation in the name of the winning Rotarian.** If there is more than one Rotarian that sponsors the Interact Club, and both are nominated, or if there is a tie, the prize will be split.

***Service Projects of the Year (See Interact Project Data Form on Pages #3-4)***

Nominations for the following awards must be documented on a completed *Interact Project Data Form* (see pages 3-4) including a written description. Photographs taken of the activity are strongly encouraged. Indicate the category at the top of the form.

**1. International:** This category involves the participation of the club in a project of an international character. This could include, for example, partnering with a foreign Interact Club in a specific project, or participation in an international relief project. **A \$100 donation to an international project of your choice, or a \$100 check will be given to your club to be used for your own international project.**

**2. Community:** This category involves the participation of the club members in a project that directly benefits their local community. The project must involve the hands-on participation of **at least 50%** of your club members, and needs to be a "sweat-equity project", not a fundraising project. **A \$100 donation will be made to a local community organization selected by the winning Interact Club, or for their Interact club's own community service project.**

**3. School:** This category involves the participation of the club in a project that supports school spirit, raises student awareness about Interact on campus or improves the campus environment. **A \$100 donation will be made to your Interact club to benefit the project.**

**4. End Polio Now:** This category involves the participate of the club in a project or fundraiser which benefited Rotary's End Polio Now program to eradicate polio. **A \$100 donation will be made to your club specifically for your End Polio Now project or fundraiser.**
