Best of luck! **We will only count the tasks as completed if you have photo/video proof of each one. If you post a picture/video on Instagram/Facebook/Twitter with the #District5890Interact or #D5890InteractExpo2016 it counts as double!**

- Take a picture with a person from a different Interact club
- Create a secret handshake with a person from a different Interact club
- Win a game of rock paper scissors against a person from a different Interact club
- Successfully land a bottle flip with a person from a different Interact club
- Dance to Juju on that Beat with a person from a different Interact club
- Take 3 members and create a human pyramid with 3 members from a different Interact club
- Get all your members in a picture with all the members from a different Interact club
- Trade your left shoe lace with a person from a different Interact club
- Just take a picture with a person from a different Interact club

- Take a picture with your favorite Expo booth
- Get a person from a different club to spontaneously do 10 jumping jacks with you
- Get someone to recite Rotary’s “Four Way Test” with you
- Take pictures with 3 members of a different Interact Club in the photobooth
- Student pretend-driving a school bus
- Make a star with 4 other members (connecting snow/grass angels)
- Get a sponsor to do the watch me whip dance with 3 or more members
- Take a picture with Sylvia Whitlock
- Video of 5 Interact club members saying the phrase “Together Everyone Achieves More” (or something along those lines) in 5 different foreign language
- Sit with someone from a different club at lunch
- Find someone who is wearing the same color shoes as you
- Find someone who has the same name as you
- Introduce yourself to a new person and repeat everything they say after you have given them your name (like name, age, grade, school, favorite food, favorite show)

- Tie together 10 shoelaces, make a circle of it, and then make as many people as possible sit inside the circle (if you want to use more shoelaces to secure bonus points for the biggest circle, go for it!) (yay or nay?)
- Make a 30-60 second dance choreography with a group of friends (with members from your own club and/or members from other clubs-> if there are other interact members in it, they too will get points for the said choreography)
- Make a team chant that rocks
- Make a funny or dramatic skit relating to team building and serving others (counts as 3 tasks)
