## APPLICATIONS WILL BE GRADED ON A POINTS SYSTEM. POINTS WILL BE ASSIGNED BASED ON HOW WELL THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA IS MET. THE RESULTING POINT VALUE WILL BECOME THE BASIS FOR THE GRANT AWARD:

- Application will not be accepted if received after the deadline (August 15, 2023).
- Application will not be considered if it does not include a media plan and Club (Rotary) recognition plan.
- Points will be deducted if all questions are not answered completely.
- For a project that features sustainability, application should explain how the project is to be maintained (e.g. agreement with parks and recreation, agreement with county government, agreement with the school or other property on which the project has been established, etc.).
- Points will be awarded proportionately based on the Club's past 3-year average of Annual Fund contributions with a target goal of at least \$100 per capita. Points deducted for <\$100 per capita; points added for >\$100 per capita.
- Project should align with one of Rotary's seven Areas of Focus.
- Project should involve hands-on, direct involvement by Club members.
- Points will be deducted if the project includes ineligible activities or expenditures described in Rotary's Terms and Conditions for District Grants (pdf download from District Grants page on D5910 website) or otherwise does not comply with Rotary's Terms and Conditions.
