For high school age young people for whom it fits, it is truly the opportunity of a lifetime. It is an unparalleled way for young people to discover who they are, develop self-reliance, and while they are at it, to discover the world around them. They learn how the people of the world think and what they value – and they teach others about their own culture. But why should it matter to the rest of us?

Learning how other people think and what they value is critical to solving the problems that face our communities and our world. What better way for a young future leader to get started on this task than to live in another culture for a school year – or even a few weeks – as a Rotary Youth Exchange Student.

- Rotary Youth Exchange is the most secure, because students are in the hands of local Rotarians in the host community, local leaders with a genuine interest in their welfare.
- It provides the **best and broadest experience**, because students are able to live as a member of at least two (usually three) carefully selected host families and through direct interaction with Rotarians from a variety of businesses and professions.
- It is the most cost effective of all youth exchange programs, because it is operated by unpaid Rotary volunteers. (Moreover, students who participate in the school year program receive an allowance from their host Rotary clubs.)
- And for participating students, the experience provides the best possible opportunity to develop self-reliance and self-confidence, to see another part of the world, to learn a new language (usually acquiring 12-15 semester hours university credit by exam), and to add a valuable dimension to their professional resume.
