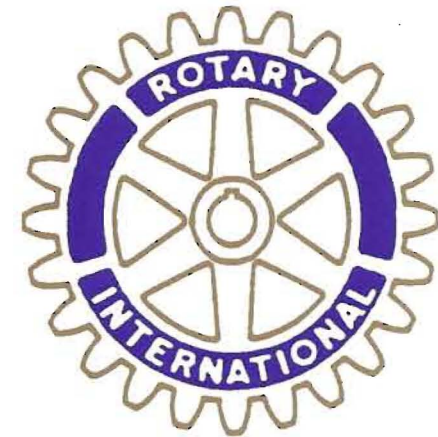

The Absence of "Official Creed": Rotary is an open society – of men and women who simply believe in helping others.

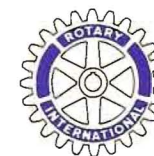
The Opportunity To Serve: Rotarians provide community service to both the local and international communities.
