**Benefit to Others**

**Community Benefit (1 - 20 points)**

**Sustainable Positive Impact on the Local Community**

**Underserved / Disadvantaged Individuals (1 – 10 points)**

**Defined as providing a need or service to those individuals who otherwise would not have the opportunity to attain or enjoy the benefit provided by the club project**

**Rotary's Public Image (1-20 points)**

**Temporary / Permanent**

**Two categories provide the club with credit for projects which may not be able to utilize permanent signage while emphasizing the positive long term impact for those projects where it is an alternative**

**Club Engagement (1 – 20 points)**

**Monetary Contribution / Member Engagement**

**(includes sweat equity)**

**Two categories provide the club with credit for projects whereby there is not a potential for member involvement while also providing credit for a club that contributes through member participation for community awareness**

**Club Support to Annual Fund (1 – 30 points)**

**Rotary suggests that Every Member Every Year (EMEY) contribute \$100 annually to the Foundation to support local and international projects to benefit third parties. It becomes a point of emphasis that without contributions there will not be grant funds to award individual clubs**
