

- 1. Before applying for a Community Service Grant, a club must be qualified by District 6000.
- 2. Projects must take place within the geographical boundaries of District 6000.
- 3. A club may fund up to 25% of the project budget with sweat equity.
- 4. A club may apply for a maximum of \$5000.
- 5. A club must match grant funds 1:1 with club finds (or equivalent).
- 6. A club must have its membership goal, Annual Fund goal and PolioPlus goal entered on MyRotary and have all prior years' Final Reports submitted and approved before they can receive grant funds.
