

Rotary District 6000 Annual Meeting Minutes, April 2, 2022

The annual meeting of 66 clubs in District 6000 was held on Saturday, April 2, 2022, during Spring Educational Assembly at the Newton DMACC Learning Center and started at 9:28 a.m. Club Presidents-elect and representatives were present in person and virtually. They will take on their leadership roles in their respective clubs beginning July 1, 2022.

There was a quorum of club officers and representatives in attendance. They approved the meeting agenda and previous year's annual meeting minutes.

The District annual financial statements were distributed electronically prior to this meeting. No members had any questions or objections. Rotarian Jon Dunwell of the Rotary Club of Newton made the motion to accept the annual financial statements and Rotarian Bill Koellner of the Rotary Club of West Liberty seconded it. Motion approved.

The District proposed budget for 2022-2023 was distributed electronically prior to this meeting. Rotarian Chris Bertelson of the Rotary Club of Winterset made the motion to accept the proposed budget for 2022-2023 as presented and Rotarian Steve Dakin from the Rotary Club of Boone seconded it. Motion approved.

The PE's approved Dave Cook of the Rotary Club of Boone as the District Governor Nominee Designee and he will serve as DG for the 2024 -2025 Rotary year. Rotarian Susan Herrick of the Rotary Club of Boone made the motion. Rotarian Bill Koellner of the Rotary Club of West Liberty seconded the motion. Motion approved.

In continuation of the recommendation that was made by the District Board of Directors and approved last year was to increase the diversity of its members. The District Board added at large directors to serve staggered three-year terms. These included: Shawn Mullen (Des Moines) (2022-2023) and Scott Naumann (Bettendorf) (2023-2024). DGE Steve Wieneke of the Rotary Club of Ankeny recommended that Norlan Hinke of the Rotary Club of Clinton replace Michelle Cassabaum from the Rotary Club of Nevada, as the next District At Large Director to the District Board for a 3-year term (2024- 2025). DGE Steve Wieneke of Ankeny also recommended that John Schroeder of the Rotary Club of Bloomfield and Susan Davis of the Rotary Club of Marengo be appointed to serve on the Board for the term (2022-2023). Rotarian Patty Mungia of the Rotary Club of Ankeny made the motion. Rotarian Doug Jones of the Rotary Club of Nevada seconded the motion. Motion approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:38 a.m.
