## Team Reports: Dennis Drager

- \*PDG Steve W-Larry Thein has been meeting with clubs regarding membership (7 possible new members through the RI portal inquiries)
- \*PDG Steve W-previewed RLI in October; 8 people are registered currently; requested advocating for the RLI to come
- \*DGE Dave commented on District 6000 membership's fast start; RI has embraced District 6000 materials to develop "Service Companion Clubs"; Retention will be a future focus
- \*PDG Jim Patton reported that at this time there is not a Global Scholar candidate. The committee will be meeting in November and will focus on the Global Scholar.
- \*DGN Norlan commented on the Major Donor Foundation meetings: numbers attending varied; depth of discussion was "solid", Rachel Greenhoe attended and met with some donors
- \*PDG Steve D will be visiting clubs to share Foundation information
- \*DG Dennis shared that a "Foundation Social" will be meeting soon in Iowa City, Bettendorf, and future in Central Iowa (Des Moines), Boone/Ames/Jefferson areas. This is an educational opportunity for members to learn about the Rotary Foundation, as well as enjoy socializing.
- \*Marie reported on Interact: RC of Boone has started a new club, Trey in Keokuk has made contact to start activities there; a District Youth Program through Zoom will be held October 2 including Interact, RYLA, Youth Exchange, and World Affairs. RYLA attendees are instrumental in developing the Interact Clubs in Marshalltown and Boone.
- \*DG Dennis has visited 39 clubs

- \*Presented his budget plan to the B/F meeting earlier
- \*One Summit via online, viewing as a club, discuss, and apply: Focus would be on Area of Focus which they are not currently working on, and what can the Club do for their community in that Area of Focus \*Training NCPETS will be in February.

\*34% of Rotarians who have dropped membership were only members for 2 year or less. Focus on what the Club can do to retain members and engage them as Rotarians

- \*International Convention in Singapore: 7 registered at this time, encouraging sign up
- \*Plans being made for District 6000's social in Singapore, paired with District 5970
- \*DGN Norlan moved development of a Super EREY, a program which Verne Folkmann has been working on, seconded by Bill-Motion Approved Motion
