First Step in Voting Process

1. Each member will receive 4 voting dots today.
2. Use ***1 of your voting dots*** to cast your vote for the ***Area of Focus*** that interests you the most.

4. After everyone has voted, we'll have a better understanding of which ***Areas of Focus*** our members are most interested in ***adding***.

Next Step – Breakout Groups
