Polio Facts

- Primarily affects children under 5 year of age
- RI launched Polio Plus in 1985
- More than 2,5 billion children have been immunized
- 17,400,000 children saved from paralysis by Polio since 1988
- In, 2018, there were 29 WPV cases in only two countries
- Polio cases have been reduced by 99.9% since 1988
- Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation match \$2 for every \$1 raised by Rotary to fund Polio eradication



District 6040 Facts

- Raised over \$71,431 last year for Polio
