

Rotary Grants Online Training Requirements for Rotary D6040

TRF requires Clubs to be grants qualified.

- Grants management training will be conducted via online training modules on the Rotary International website in the MyRotary Learning Center. The login to the site is found at: <https://my.rotary.org/en/login>. You need a myRotary account to sign in and take the courses. If you do not have an account you can register for one on the <http://rotary.org> website.
- The Learning Center is found under the Learning & Reference tab. There are two required courses:
 - Grant Management Seminar (Learning Plan containing 10 different courses)
 - Grant Management Recertification 2021-22.

To be Grants Qualified for the 2022/2023 Rotary year, the:

- The 2022-2023 Club President and Club Grants Manager, a minimum of two people, must complete on-line Grants Management Training by June 15, 2022.
- The 2022-2023 Club President and President-Elect must submit a signed Memorandum of Understanding to the District Grants Sub-Committee Chair, Beth Franklin, bethfranklin@kw.com by June 15, 2022.
