

2025 Rotary District Life Leadership Conference:
LLC What to Wear, What to Bring, and What Not to Bring (revised 5/20/25)

What to Wear:

- Casual, comfortable, and appropriate clothing for four days
- Sneakers or comfortable shoes for walking
- Work out clothing for recreation times (& optional morning workouts)
- You will also need one dressier outfit for one evening. This dressier outfit is up to you and what you find comfortable – this could include dress pants, blouses, button-down shirts, skirts, dresses, or a suit (with or without a tie)

What to Bring:

- Flip flops/water shoes for the shower
- Photo ID
- Water bottle
- Snacks
- Prescription medication (if you need special storage, please let staff know upon arrival)
- Backpack or small bag to carry items with you during the day (once we leave the dorms in the morning, we usually aren't back in them until late at night!)
- Bed linens or a sleeping bag (this includes pillow(s)/pillow cases) for a twin-size mattress
- Bathroom toiletries including hand soap, towels, as well as a blow dryer or any styling tools (toilet paper and a shower curtain are the only supplies in the dorms)
- Sunscreen
- Rain coat/umbrella
- Notebook and writing utensils if you like to take notes

Optional items:

- Fan (this one is highly recommended as the dorms are not air conditioned!)
- Clothes hangers: whatever amount you want for clothing that you'd like to hang up
- Workout clothes, sports equipment (no skateboards or roller blades). If you choose to bring sports equipment, please label it accordingly and store it in your dorm room during non-recreation times
- Talent Show materials (if you would like to participate and it requires materials beyond a chair and microphone/music stand)
- If you choose to bring any electronic devices for recreation times, you will be responsible for their security

DO NOT Bring:

- Anything that could be taken for a weapon
- Tobacco, vaping devices, alcohol, illegal drugs, or recreational drugs
- Any potentially dangerous materials (fireworks, etc.)

For International Students:

- Electronic (PPT, flash drive, etc.) files about your country
- Flag or other materials you wish to share about your country
