### DISTRICT GRANTS

The available DDF for District Grants in the 2013/14 Rotary year is US\$54,299.

Twenty-one District Grant proposals from D6330 clubs were received by the April 30, 2013 deadline.

Twenty of these were approved for a full application. One Global Scholar application is included in this total.

\$54,256 of the available DDF has been committed to these applications.

The project value of the approved proposals is \$171,835.

Eight full applications have been received and approved up to November 23, 2013.

Applications must be received before December 31, 2013.

Projects must be completed and a Final Report submitted and approved prior to April 30, 2014.
