Afghanistan:

- No wild polioviurs type 1 cases was reported this week. There is one case reported in 2021. while the total number of 2020 cases remain 56.
- Six cases of circulating vaccine-derived poliovirus type 2 (cVDPV2) were reported; one each in Zabul,
 Kandahar, Ghazni and Badghis and two in Farah making them the first of 2021. The total number of 2020 cases remain 305.

Pakistan:

- One wild poliovirus type 1 (WPV1) case was reported in Balochistan making it the first of 2021. The
 total number of 2020 cases remain 84.
- Six WPV1 positive environmental samples were reported; two each in Sindh and Balochistan and one each in Punjab and Islamabad.
- Two cases of circulating vaccine-derived poliovirus type 2 (cVDPV2) were reported; one each in Balochistan and Khyber Pakhtoon bringing the 2021 case count to three. The number of 2020 cases remain 135.
- Five cVDPV2 positive environmental samples were reported; two in Sindh and one each in Balochistan, Punjab and Khyber Pakhtoon.
