Healing More Little Haitian Hearts

Gift of Life International is proud to work together with Rotarians, hospital administrators, healthcare professionals and like-minded partners to bring hope to Haitian children with heart disease. We are the only consortium of non-profit organizations currently in Haiti performing heart surgery either on children or adults. Without us, these children have no hope of receiving treatment.

The October 2018 mission trip was our 17th to Haiti since 2012. During this mission week, 10 year old Tanica was the 300th Haitian child to receive care through our consortium. A total of 14 children were treated for their heart ailments with a 100% success rate. The complexity of cases was also increased slightly this week.

Our sincere thanks to the visiting healthcare professionals from Ospedale Pediatrico Gaslini in Genoa, Italy, led by pediatric cardiac surgeons Dr. Francesco Santoro and Dr. Elena Ribera, and from Akron Children's Hospital in Akron, Ohio, as well as doctors and nurses who joined the team from other U.S. and Canadian Hospitals. Thank you to the Haitian team, under the direction of Dr. Jacqueline Gautier, who worked side by side with visiting team members to enhance their skills in caring for Haitian children with heart disease.




