<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Participating clubs must meet all of District requirements for District grants (MOU, Goals, GMS training) ✓ Clubs need not have a current year 2020-21 District grant or Global Grant ✓ Projects must be located in District 6440. ✓ Clubs must include a public relations plan with their grant application ✓ Applications available on the District webpage - link 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Minimum of 3 clubs per project participating ✓ Quality of hands on component ✓ Uniqueness of project-creativity-addressing a need that has not often been part of district grants ✓ Project's lasting visibility for Rotary ✓ Sustainability-project must have lasting benefit to the community ✓ Projects which involve community partners which have not been involved in previous district grants. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Clubs must match District DDF with cash on a 1:1 basis ✓ Each club must pledge a minimum of \$500 and maximum of \$1000 ✓ Projects must be completed by June 30, 2021 ✓ Maximum DDF award is \$10,000 ✓ Applications must be received by January 31, 2021
