Information meeting November 2nd, Wednesday at the Barrington Area Library., 6:00pm, Zimmerman Room (second floor.)

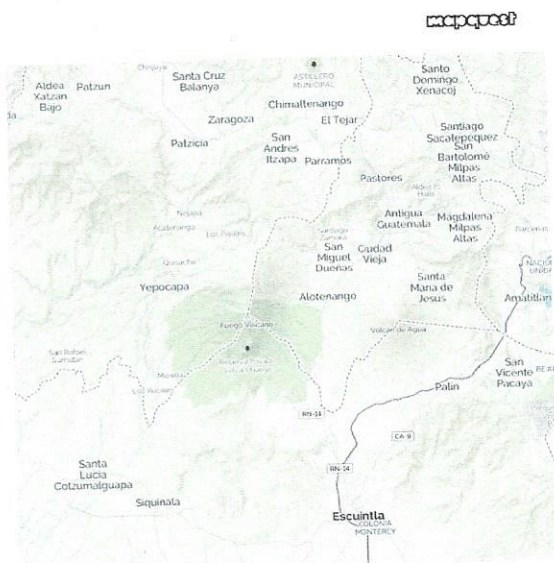
Where: Santa Maria de Jesus, a Mayan community on the slope of Volcano Agua, outside Antigua, Guatemala. Mission Impact, a non-denominational US registered 501(c)3 non-profit, has collaborated with Rotary in establishing the Rotary Nutrition Center and installing a mechanical cow at Proximos Pasos school for girls (2011-2012) and in establishing the Rotary Vocational Center in neighboring Santa Lucia Milpaz Altas.

Fee \$1650: includes airfare, hotel in Antigua (double occupancy), breakfast, lunch most dinners, transportation to and from work sites, and some work materials.

Trip is limited to 16 persons.

November 5: \$90 deposit due for airline ticket.

Goals of the trip:

Build a greenhouse with hydroponic and aquaponic components alongside community members for educational and microenterprise purposes.

Conduct a literacy project for the girls at Proximos Pasos school.

Teach the girls to play chess with simple step by step instructions.
