MOST COMMON QUESTIONS INVOLVE DDF

- How much DDF does my club have to spend?
- Has my club committed DDF to any Global Grant?
- What Global Grants has my club pledged to?
- What clubs in D6440 have DDF to pledge to Global Grants & how much?

FOR EVERY CLUB INVOLVED IN GLOBAL GRANTS: PARTICIPANTS & HOSTS

- Hosts: (1) The club In-Country (where the project takes place) “the Host”, (2) The partnering club outside of that country who works to fund raise & make the global grant happen, “the International Host”.
- Participant: A club that pledges cash &/or DDF to a Global Grant

Note: Our D6440 District is Different ! We may be the only district which allows clubs in our district to control “their DDF”.
