Project Name: Chicuchas Wasi Foundation/Huillcapata School Project

Location: Cusco Peru and adjoining rural area

Project Time Completion: 5 Days

Summary of Project: Project had two parts. The Chicuchas Wasi Foundation portion of the project involved upgrading the environment of an educational institution that provides schooling for girls in high risk and low income in the city of Cusco Peru. The project involved upgrading exterior walls at the school with murals that symbolize and express the values of those at the school. This portion of the project enhanced the environment for the girls who are at high risk due to their environment. The enhancement of a perimeter wall through art was intended to symbolize the values the school is trying to impart on the girls, further strengthening the opportunities and chances for these girls to succeed.

The Huillcapata School portion of the project involved the installation of piping and agrofilm for a greenhouse at the school, prepping a building for remodeling and restoration of a worm farm. This aspect of the project was intended to enhance the agricultural efforts of the school to aid the students.

The Lake in the Hills Club conducted the project in partnership with the Rotary Club of Julio Delgado - Cusco Peru.
