Summary of Project:

A Global Grant to build an off-grid sewage treatment system serving 100+ people in a Bedouin village in the Negev region of southern Israel.

District 6440 Rotary clubs contributed \$21,000+ matched by DDF.

We are partnering with Jewish National Fund (JNF) who provides feasibility analysis and support in sustainability. The success of this project is very important to JNF, to launch similar systems in other Bedouin villages where raw sewage is a problem.
