Rotary has designated January as Vocational Service Month. The Object of Rotary is a philosophical statement of Rotary’s purpose and the responsibilities of Rotarians. The concept of vocational service is rooted in the second “Object of Rotary”, which calls on Rotarians to encourage and foster:

- High Ethical Standards in business and professions
- The recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, and
- The dignifying of each Rotarian’s occupation as an opportunity to service society.
