Premise- Here in Northern Illinois, we are truly spoiled! Our water source, Lake Michigan is a short walk away, and it contains 6 quadrillion gallons of water, providing a billion gallons daily to all who draw their fresh water supply from it. If we were to empty the Great Lakes onto the entire United States, it would create a lake that was 9.5 feet deep on average across the entire 48 contiguous states. To say the least, we take it for granted.

Problem-85% of the world's population live in the driest half of the planet, and 683 million people do not have access to clean water.

Pain-Lack of access to clean water causes poverty...not the other way around. Lack of clean water is a breeding ground for disease. Sick people are not productive people. Lack of clean water devastates agriculture which starves people. Starving people are not productive people.
