Attraction


Engagement

Set Goals!




Identify

- Ask members to complete the Identifying Prospective Members Assessment
- Classification Assessment for Gaps
- Membership Leads in the Club Administration area of My Rotary







Introduce

- Periodically hold special events for prospective members.
- Invite to a service project or social
- Tell prospective members what to expect at meeting
- Highlight the opportunities for networking, social and service.

Invite

Designate

Appropriate club member to invite prospective member to join.

Ceremony

Meaningful ceremony to induct new members. Include families.

Welcome Kit

New Member welcome kit that includes club and Rotary resources.

Celebrate

Celebrate new members on your website, social media and newsletter.


