There are two:

1. Active
2. Honourary

1. Rotary International fees
Dues – fixed
2. District fees breakdown:
Dues \$60.00 – fixed
Conference \$10.00 – fixed
Insurance \$21.06 – fixed
3. Club fees:
Dues - negotiable

Alternate Membership Types

There are three:

1. Corporate
2. Affiliate
3. Family

Alternate Membership Types

- Corporate

A corporate entity or organization can become an eligible corporate member of a Rotary Club by following a Club's new member approval process.

Alternate Membership Types

- Affiliate

An Affiliate Member will become associated and acquainted with a Rotary club, its members, its programs and projects, and the expectations of club membership with the intent of becoming an active member within a designated period of time.

Alternate Membership Types

- Family

An adult family member in the same household can become an eligible member of a Rotary Club by following a Club's new member approval process.

Satellite Clubs

Satellite Clubs are simply an extension of the Sponsor Club and offer an alternative meeting time and place to the Sponsor Club. A member of a Satellite Club is a member of the Sponsor Club and subject to the same rules as any other Rotarian.
