

Cancer Detection and Education - Mobile Clinic



Public cancer facilities in India are woefully inadequate and though private cancer care facilities are available in bigger cities, they are not within the reach of a common person. As a result of the great increase in Cancer, all public cancer treatment facilities are overcrowded and teeming with patients resulting in India's enormous Cancer problem.

The Rotary Club of Sudbury Sunrisers has worked toward easing this challenge with the introduction of a mobile Cervical Cancer Detection Clinic. This Van travels to Indian villages and is fully equipped with a cancer detection lab and equipment like a Mammography unit, X-ray machine for lungs and Pap Smear and blood sample labs for P.S.A tests and more. The goal is to detect early breast, prostate, cervical, lung, and other organ cancers and to create awareness among the public about the early symptoms of all types of cancer. In addition, the mobile clinic shares resources on Cancer prevention related to the use of Tobacco & Cigarettes, alcohol, and certain high-risk foods.
