The humanitarian situation in Gaza continues to deteriorate. Temporary shelters are wearing out quickly from harsh weather, overcrowding and constant movement. Unfortunately no new shelter materials are being allowed through the borders.

To help protect people from harsh conditions, rodent infestations and poor sanitary conditions, ShelterBox has launched a new project focused on upgrading shelters through procuring locally available materials.

Working with our local partner from our previous projects in Gaza when we could deliver tents, we are purchasing locally available materials to repair and strengthen deteriorating shelters.

For families who have lost everything, your support is a lifeline. Thank you for making this work possible.

The focus is on families who are facing the greatest hardship and have the fewest options to rebuild on their own.

With limited supplies available for purchase we are working with local engineers to create the most robust structures possible with what we can buy.

Community members have also been trained and paid to help with shelter repairs, providing employment, skills, and income at a difficult time.

Once we are able to bring tents across the border again, we will do so to meet the overwhelming humanitarian need.
