Water Crisis in First Nation Communities

THE ISSUE

40% of First Nation Communities in Ontario are under a Boil Water Advisory.

Many First Nations have identified the need for more young, qualified, and local personnel to support solving water issues, independently and for the long term.





THE PROGRAM

WATER FIRST partners with Indigenous communities in Canada to address critical drinking water challenges.

The Water First Internship Program supports young Indigenous interns to become certified water treatment plant operators, ensuring sustainable access to safe drinking water in Indigenous communities for the long term. In 15 months, interns receive over 2,000 hours of training and experience in the classroom, at local water treatment facilities, and out on the land to obtain three provincially recognized certifications.

In the first program, within eight weeks of graduating, 90% of interns were working in the field or pursuing further study
