

Procedure/ Timeline for Submissions to and Participation in Council on Legislation



January 24, 2022

This document is provided as a guide for submitting enactments to the Council on Legislation (COL) held every 3 years and providing input on the voting process.

Every three years, Rotarians meet at the <u>Council on Legislation</u> to review and vote on proposed changes to the legislation that governs Rotary. They consider enactments, which change Rotary's governing documents, and position statements by the RI Board.

Steps to submitting an enactment to the COL in District 7010i

- Propose an enactment for ratification by your club.
- Club submits enactment to the District
- District presents proposed enactment at a District meeting for ratification by the clubs
- Approved enactments are submitted to RI

Voting on enactments

- Endorsed enactments are circulated to clubs for comments
- Endorsed District enactments are voted on by clubs
- Approved enactments are submitted to RI and TRF Board's for consideration

A Council on Legislation representative is elected by the clubs for a 3-year term, The COL rep attends COL and casts the District vote.

September	Enactments are reviewed by the Executive
	Enactments are circulated to the clubs for review
September to	Enactments are considered at a District meeting open to all District 7010 Rotarians. (at
November	District conference or online)
	Proposing club has an opportunity to present and explain the proposed enactment and
	respond to questions
	Enactments are discussed and voted on by Club representatives
December 30th	DG confirms District endorsement of enactment
	Endorsed enactments are submitted to RI Council office by Dec 30 th
January to	Council office may reject improperly drafted enactments or recommend edits
September	Enactments are finalized
October to	COL rep completes mandatory training
December	Vetting process for selected enactments which are identified as non contentious occurs
	COL rep casts vote for vetting process Dec 31
January	Enactments posted
February/March	District meeting held to review and discuss enactments and provide input to COL rep
April	COL rep attends Council and cast District vote

NOTES:

Final decisions are made by the COL rep at the Council on Legislation after listening to and considering all comments and discussion.
