Typically, each District Governor (DG) establishes the *District Governor Club Achievement Recognition* or *DG Club Achievement Award*, for the Rotary year [July 1st – June 20th], that sets out 15 to 20 goals, asking the clubs to then achieve a set number of these goals over the course of the year.

Please enter your goal(s), interest(s), etc. and share them with your Assistant Governor (AG).

Your AG will check in with your club periodically during the year to see how you are doing and offer any advice as requested.

The deadline for reporting the club's results to your AG is July 15, 2020.

Participating clubs will be formally recognized at a District Rotary function in 2020-2021, most likely at the District Conference 2020.
