



Club Achievement Recognition 2018 - 2019



To achieve the Club Achievement Recognition for 2018 – 2019, clubs must complete a minimum 7 of the following by June 30 2019. Please submit the completed form to your Assistant Governor.

- Implement or participate in a project working with youth in your community or the international community: Rotaract, Interact, Earlyact, YMCA, local school
- Host a “Rotary Alumni” event or induct a Rotary alumnus into your club.
- Host a community event to highlight the foundation, polio campaign or another focus of your club that is within the six areas of focus.
- Have at least one club member travel internationally for Rotary: project, convention, VTT, friendship exchange, fellowship group
- Develop a media campaign using or developing your own “Rotary in Action” resources.
- Participate in or plan a “Rotary Day” event and promote it through the media.
- Conduct Club Assemblies quarterly and use feedback to update or modify goals and post updates on Rotary Club Central.
- Plan and implement or extend a local or international project in one of the six areas of focus.
- Have the greater of 2 or 20% of members participate in a rotary event outside your club. (Visit another club, Rotary Weekend, District Conference, International Convention, zone institute/conference, multi club project)
- Have all members participate in at least one club event during the course of the year. This could include a service project, fundraising activity or club initiative such as planning a Foundation dinner or membership event, or mentoring new members or youth. (All members do not have to participate in the same event)
- Successfully apply for a Global Grant, District Grant, “Dare to Dream” membership monies or Public Image monies.
