Monday

Afternoon spent with First Peoples' House of Learning and Tracks program.

Evening spent at Camp Kawartha Environmental Centre at Trent.

Tuesday

Travel through the 4 locks to Lakefield by lunchtime.

Cross Katchewanooka and Clear Lakes as well as Young's Point lock before late afternoon arrival at Camp Kawartha.

Wednesday

First Nation sports at Camp Kawartha before departure for Burleigh Falls and bus to Petroglyphs.

Return to Burleigh Falls and paddle Lovesick Lake to Wolf Island Provincial Park for overnight.

Thursday

Paddle Lower and Upper Buckhorn Lakes to Curve Lake Pow wow grounds for overnight.

Friday

Pack up camp.

Visit Black Duck Wild Rice (James Whetung) during morning.

Celebration feast provided by Curve Lake First Nation and closing remarks.

Ceremonial tree planting.
