

'TOP 5' Things to Ask a Prospect...when you are trying to Recruit a New Member

- 1. Why are you interested in joining Rotary? Our Club? Have you ever looked into Rotary International before? Do you know any Rotarians? (What are their interests and can Rotary/our Club respond to those interests.)
- 2. Do you know when/where our Club meets? How often we meet? (Are they aware of some of the aspects of the time commitment to be a Rotarian.)
- 3. Do you know anything about our membership fee structure? Have you ever heard of the Rotary Foundation? (Are they aware of some of the aspects of financial commitment to be a Rotarian.)
- 4. Do you know of any local Rotary projects or events that our Club is involved with? (Do they have a basic knowledge of the types of projects and activities our Club is involved with in our community.)
- 5. Do you know of any Rotary projects or programs internationally? (Do they have a basic knowledge of projects or initiatives such as Polio eradication, literacy, children's education, clean water, Shelterbox, etc.)
