WHAT IS RLI?

The Rotary Leadership Institute is a grassroots-training program that began in New Jersey in 1992 by club Rotarians.

Its purpose is to help individual Rotarians and Rotaractors and future club leaders prepare for their club and community roles through a quality training and educational experience.

The RLI has spread to more than 200 districts in numerous countries because local clubs recognize the importance of training future leaders as well as have knowledgeable club members.

HOW WE FIT INTO RLI?

As we know Rotary District 7010 is part of the Shining Waters Division which is part of Zone 28 & 32.

- 7070 joined RLI in 2009 as the first member in the new Shining Waters Division, Ontario, upper New York State and Eastern Michigan.
- Followed shortly thereafter with District 7090, 7080 and 6330.
- District 7010 joined the division in 2011 expanding further into northeastern Ontario.



SO, WHAT REALLY IS RLI?




RLI is a compilation of lessons that are broken down into three parts. Each part is delivered over three consecutive weeks with each week broken down into either one or two lessons lead by trained facilitators.

QUESTIONS YOU MAY HAVE?

- Can I do Part Three before Part One?
 Unfortunately, no. All the lessons have been created to a progression of information.
- If I have taken a Part in previous years but did not complete the whole series, do I have to do the part(s) over again?
 It depends on when you took the part(s). There has been some changes to RI and The Rotary Foundation's information and policies so it might be a good idea to retake them, however only a suggestion.
- What if I need to miss one of the classes in the part that I am taking?
 We make arrangements to do a makeup, preferably the week or two after the missed lesson by one of the Facilitators or Colin Thacker, past RLI Chair.
- What is the time commitment?
 Each of the classes are two hours long, on a Saturday, and are online using the Zoom platform. We have everyone sign in ten minutes early so that we start promptly at 9am and finish at 11am.

QUESTIONS YOU MAY HAVE?

- Is there any other time to take the different parts?
 We currently only deliver the sessions once a year each however other Districts in our Zone allows us to schedule our members in their sessions. Note however, some are in person and there is an added cost.
- What if I don't remember what I have done in RLI previously?
 We have a database of all of the participants over the years so contact me through email to find out.
- Who can take RLI?
 Any active Rotary member or Rotaractor.
- Who are the facilitators?
 We have a great breadth of fantastic and knowledgeable Facilitators who are from our region who are current or past District Governors, Presidents, Chairs of District Committees, and Assistant District Governors. All have taken the Facilitator courses as well received updated materials from RLI to ensure you are getting the most recent information.

WHAT'S NEXT?

- Is there anything after the three parts of RLI?
 Yes there is. We are currently exploring the next level of training sessions through RLIs Graduate Courses. We will need to train our facilitators and plan for the program to be added to our current curriculum.
- Is there a French version of the materials?

 RLI has created a French version however we have the District (Lise Dutrisac) looking at the materials. We also need French-speaking Facilitators who have been trained in the materials. This is currently pending.
