Schools that have achieved a certain level of rating will receive an honour board to be placed in their school in a prominent area for all to see. These schools will be designated a <u>Rotary Peace School</u>. Schools that have submitted an application but have not been designated a Rotary Peace School will be awarded a certificate of participation.

Schools with the highest number of points will receive an honour board and Rotary Peace Pole, which will be planted on their school property. Children from schools with the highest ratings will be invited to the Rotary Club of xxxxx and receive xxxxxx/
