

Club District Grant Application Guidelines 2022-2023

*Receive a matching district grant for up to \$2,000USD
– it's as simple as 1, 2, 3!*

#1. QUALIFY YOUR CLUB from July 1, 2021 to April 30, 2022

To be eligible to sign the Club Grants MOU, and participate in district grants, such as: collaborative club grants, VTT, Scholarships, and Foundation district offerings, a club is required to qualify by having:

- Club dues must be in good standing
- Enter Rotary Foundation goals and active Foundation Chair assigned into My Rotary
- A minimum of 2 ACTIVE members completes any combination of the following:

#2. MOU (Memorandum of Understanding)

- Upon qualifying your club, you may now submit the MOU, anytime prior to submitting an application!
- The MOU is available at: www.Rotary7090.org>Committees>Foundation>2022-2023 Grants and must be signed by the current President and President Elect.

#3. APPLY FOR A DISTRICT MATCHING GRANT

- On line submissions will be accepted between September 1, 2021 to April 30, 2022
- Go to: www.Rotary7090.org > login > Member Area > Grants > Submit a Grant Request
- Start with a pre-submission to sound out your idea with the committee.
- Applications will be based on completed applications only and available funding.
- Priority will be given to clubs that collaborate on their application by having two or more clubs apply with one application. Each club must be qualified and have submitted an MOU. Each club's funding will be matched up to \$2,000USD. One club must be the designated lead for the application as well as for the final report.
- Final reports are due two months after completion of the project and no later than April 30, 2023.
