- Go to Rotary Learning Centre and in particular take the courses created for future District Governors - there are both basic, intermediate and advanced sessions.
- Review the Governor Manual and other checklists published by Rotary International
- Find out the dates for Governor Elect Training (GETS) and other Zone Training planned put those dates in your calendar.
- Read past 7090 Council minutes and materials all found on our District website and regularly attend District Council meetings going forward
- Review the 7090 Strategic Plan and get engaged in the creation of goals for the coming years - including your year as Governor. We are aiming to have the District's goals as closely aligned as possible with the Governors goals.
- Read the Manual of Policies as well as the District 7090 By-Laws
