- ~ HAVE CLUB MEMBERS (MINIMUM 1) JOIN THE ROTARY ACTION GROUP AGAINST SLAVERY IN CANADA AND THE ROTARY ACTION GROUP AGAINST SLAVERY**
- ~ PARTICIPATE IN THE DISTRICT HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS INITIATIVE**
- ~ HAVE CLUB MEMBERS (MORE THAN 1) JOIN THE POLIO PLUS SOCIETY (DOES NOT INCLUDE EXISTING POLIO SOCIETY MEMBERS)**
 - ~ HAVE CLUB MEMBERS (MORE THAN 1) ATTEND THE POLIO PLUS SOCIETY FELLOWSHIP EVENT AND/OR DISTRICT POLIO EVENT**
- ~ PARTICIPATE IN PRISM AWARD (CLUB PARTICIPATES IN YEARLY CHALLENGES)**
- ~ PROMOTED THEME "CREATE LASTING IMPACT" BY SHARING IMPACT STORIES FROM THOSE WHO HAVE BENEFITED FROM ROTARY SERVICE OR FUNDRAISING. SHARE THIS WITH SOCIAL MEDIA AND OTHER MEDIA SOURCES**
- ~ BE QUALIFIED AS A CLUB USING THE REVISED SIMPLIFIED GRANT QUALIFICATION PROCESS (2027-2028) AND APPLY FOR A DISTRICT GRANT OR PARTICIPATE IN A CLUSTER GRANT PROPOSAL**
- ~ EVERY ROTARIAN, EVERY YEAR (ALL MEMBERS OF THE CLUB CONTRIBUTE TO THE FOUNDATION, A MINIMUM OF \$25 USD); THE AVERAGE FOR THE CLUB IS \$100**
 - ~ ATTEND DISTRICT GALA 2027**
- ~ ONE OR MORE CLUB MEMBERS JOIN THE DISTRICT COMMITTEE OR TAKE A LEADERSHIP ROLE AT THE DISTRICT (DOES NOT INCLUDE EXISTING DISTRICT MEMBERS)**
- ~ ONE CLUB MEMBER ATTENDS A DISTRICT COUNCIL MEETING THAT IS NOT A CURRENT MEMBER OF DISTRICT COUNCIL**
