

Had at least 5 non-Rotarians participate at one of our "days of service" events such as  Great Lakes Watershed Clean-Up
Had at least one member enrolled in the Rotary Leadership Institute - Level 1.
☐ Had Club Members (more than 1) attend the District Conference
Engaged in supporting our District social media campaigns by liking and sharing content being produced on our FaceBook pages as well as Instagram and Linked In.
☐ Posted at least 3 new articles or pictures to your Rotary Club website to keep it fresh and current
$\square$ Been qualified as a club using our revised simplified grant qualification process this 2022-2023 year
