TWO-PART REGISTRATION PROCESS OPENS Wednesday, April 6, 2022

Rotary clubs pay the registration on behalf of the candidates they select. Payment must be sent to the Registrar with the completed application. There are no refunds, so be prepared to select an alternate participant

SLAPSHOT 2022 takes place over six days, May 14-19, 2022, on the virtual platform Zoom. Its focus is to maximize the promotion of leadership, self-esteem and teamwork via training in listening and interpersonal skills, assertiveness and problem-solving, team building and presentation skills. Students leave **SLAPSHOT** feeling more confident in themselves and prepared to strengthen their involvement with Interact Clubs and other initiatives that will make a difference in their schools, local communities and beyond.

SLAPSHOT brings 40 high school students throughout District 7090 together for a fun experience in, fellowship and learning. The program is founded on Rotary ideals and serves as a strong link on the continuum of Rotary's youth leadership development opportunities – Youth Exchange, RYLA, EarlyAct, Interact and Rotaract.

SLAPSHOT 2021 TWO-PART REGISTRATION PROCESS

1st complete the online CLUB REGISTRATION FORM and pay \$100 USD/student)online by credit card to **SLAPSHOT REGISTRAR**, then select student participants per **SLAPSHOT Selection Guidelines** below.

- Review **SLAPSHOT 2022 STUDENT PARTICIPANT INFORMATION & APPLICATION PACKAGE** with each student selected.
- **Secure from each student a completed SLAPSHOT 2022 APPLICATION FORM** *If the applicant is under age 18, the form must be signed by his/her parent or guardian.*
- **Complete online CLUB REGISTRATION FORM #2** on page 3 of this package.

IMPORTANT NOTICE All REGISTRATION FEES & completed CLUB & STUDENT PARTICIPANT FORMS must be received by the SLAPSHOT REGISTRAR no later than May 4, 2022.

GUIDELINES FOR SELECTING SLAPSHOT PARTICIPANT(S)

Clubs are encouraged to seek applications from young leaders, 15-19 years, who are known to members of their club or Rotary contacts in their local high schools. Applicants must be current high school students. **Students who have previously attended SLAPSHOT are NOT ELIGIBLE. This is a 'once in a lifetime' award.**

1. Applicants first present their applications to contact(s) in their high school and/or local Rotary Club, who then make a selection. The Club then forwards one copy of the completed participant applications for each of the students selected to the SLAPSHOT Registrar.
2. When selecting participants, look for maturity, enthusiasm and interest in making a positive difference in school and community. To achieve maximum benefit from SLAPSHOT, candidates should demonstrate ability to communicate effectively and work well together with student peers and their teachers.
3. Be sure that applicants understand that they must commit to full participation for the duration of the week-long program and be free from work or other commitments during all seven sessions.
4. Before forwarding the required information for each student selected to the SLAPSHOT Registrar, review the completed form to ensure completeness and accuracy of information and signatures.

RESPONSIBILITY OF PARTICIPATING ROTARY CLUBS

1. Select and sponsor SLAPSHOT participant(s) – *maximum TWO students*
2. Submit the \$100 USD per student payment with CLUB REGISTRATION FORM #1 (*p.5 of this package*)
3. Submit the *STUDENT PARTICIPANT INFORMATION & APPLICATION PACKAGE*, completed by EACH STUDENT PARTICIPANT to the SLAPSHOT Registrar NO LATER THAN MAY 4, 2022 with completed CLUB REGISTRATION FORM #2 (*p.3 of this package*)
4. Check that your sponsored participant(s) have the Zoom log-in details and protect the time for all 6 days
5. Arrange, as appropriate, for SLAPSHOT 2022 participant(s) to attend a Club meeting to speak about his/her/their experience & seek media coverage for the participant(s) and SLAPSHOT program

PAID REGISTRATION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE! *In case of last minute cancellation(s), it is important that your club selects an alternate student participant(s).*
