Your District is 7090. It:

- covers Southern Ontario and Western New York (See map at <http://www.rotary7090.org/ClubsMap>)
- is part of Rotary International Zone 24 (which includes most of Canada and parts of US near the border)
- includes 16 Areas; each Area consists of several Rotary clubs and is assigned to an Assistant Governor
- includes 68 Rotary Clubs, including 2 E-Clubs
- is known as the “Best of Friends” district due to clubs in both countries
