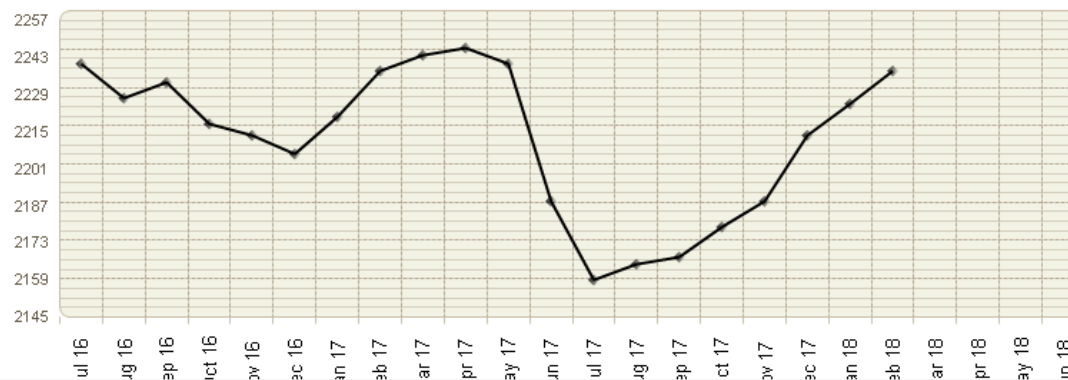

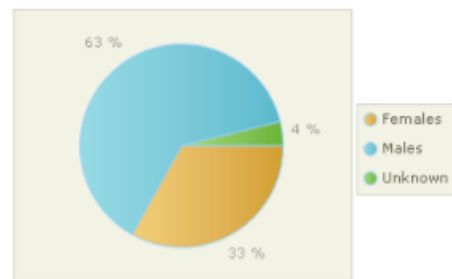

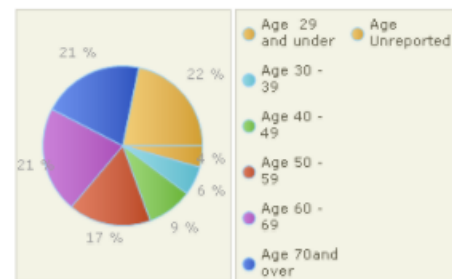
Gender Distribution Report February 2018

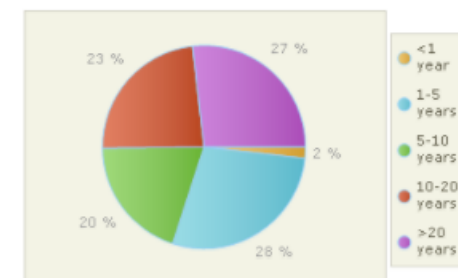
