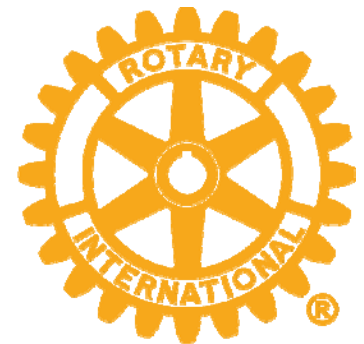

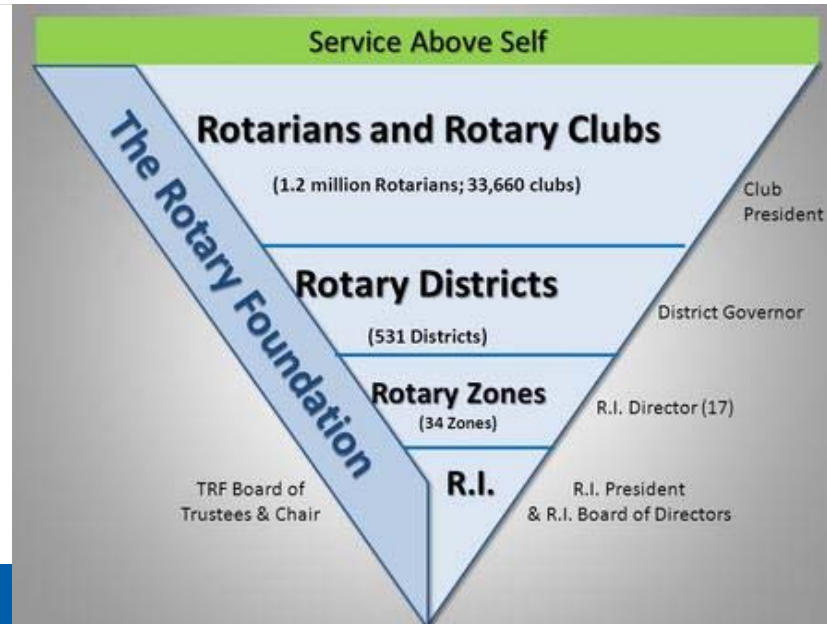

Rotary Structure

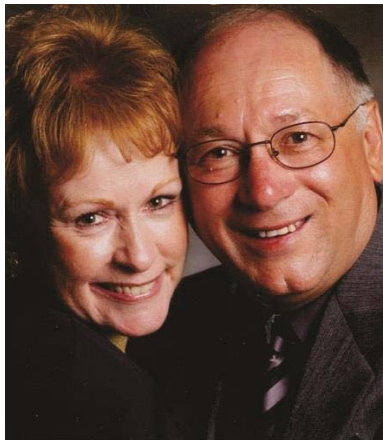
- Rotarians Join Rotary Clubs

- includes 16 Areas; each Area consists of several Rotary clubs and is assigned to an Assistant Governor

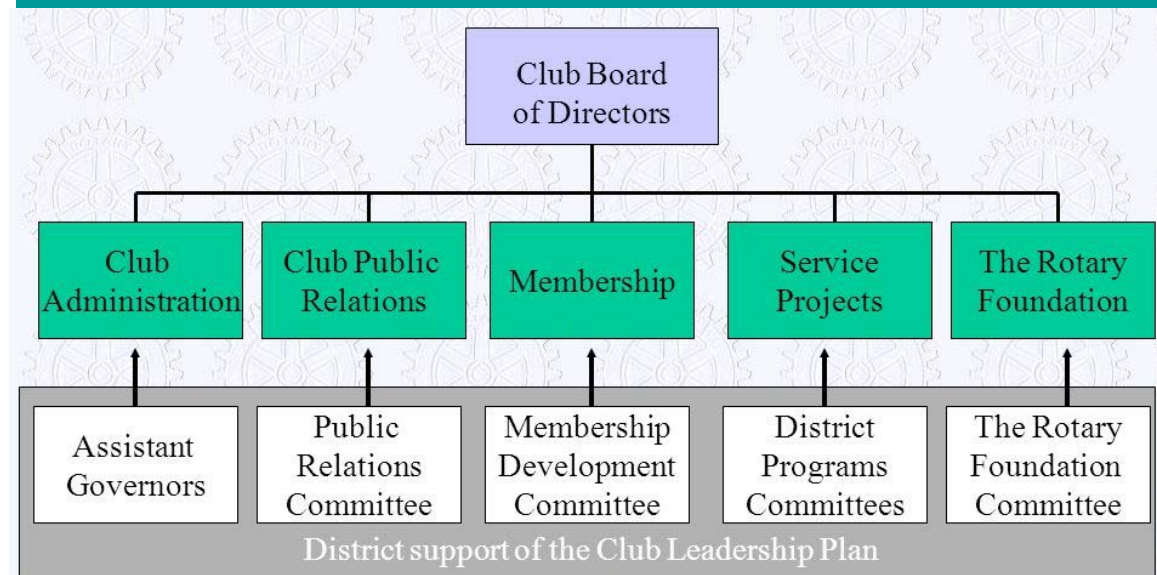


Rotary Clubs

- ✓ guides you to build strong, long term relationships with your Rotary Club, the District and Rotary International, by helping you understand the philosophy, policies and procedures of Rotary at various levels
- ✓ may be the person who sponsored you or a different member of the club (typically before your induction)
- ✓ will maintain regular contact with you, for six months to one year, or as long as necessary, to probe interests, answer questions, and anticipate upcoming events and activities so that you are prepared to carry out your role as an effective and engaged member

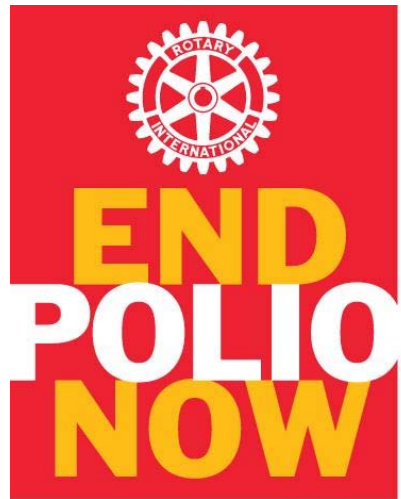
