Dear Rotary Club Presidents,

We are pleased to announce the Rotary District 7210

Every Rotarian Every Year Giving Challenge!

As you know, our Rotary Foundation is one of the important aspects of Rotary which sets us apart from other local community service organizations. The Rotary Foundation transforms our support into service projects that change lives both in our own communities and around the world. It is because of your support of The Rotary Foundation each year that we are able to generously award so many District Grants and Global Grants in support of your Clubs' Projects!

Our District's Foundation Giving Goals for the 2019-20 Rotary year include the goal of having each of our Clubs average at least \$120/member to The Rotary Foundation (TRF) Annual Fund. The Every Rotarian Every Year (EREY) Giving Challenge is intended to help your Club achieve this goal, and as a result not only increase our capacity for Doing GOOD in our communities and the world, but to also have your Club be recognized for exceeding the requirements of the prestigious EREY Banner at our annual Foundation Club Recognition Awards event.

The 2019-20 EREY Giving Challenge has two parts, as follows:

1. We are challenging every Club to ensure that **100% of their members** (defined by Rotary as "existing active members") have had donations of at least **\$25** made in each of their names to TRF's Annual Fund by December 31, 2019. Often a very simple way to accomplish this is for the Club to gather those donations and to submit them directly to TRF using the "pre-populated multiple donor form" found online at the "Club Administration" page of MyRotary.org:

2. Next, we are then challenging every Club to ensure that their Club's total donations to TRF's Annual Fund reach an **average at least \$120/member** by no later than June 30, 2020. Of course, feel free to exceed this goal, as our top Clubs typically exceed \$300/member, and to do so sooner, as there will be earlier recognition opportunities, including one at PETS 2020 on March 20! You can track your Club's progress toward this goal on the "Foundation Recognition Status Report" found under the "Rotary Foundation Giving" tab in the "Reports" section of Rotary Club Central:
