Dear Rotary Club Presidents and Presidents-Elect,

Rotary District 7210 wants to help you fund your projects to DO GOOD in the world!

Our Foundation Grants Committee is seeking local and international projects for our 2022-23 District Grants. The District Grant process is very simple if approved: apply, do good, report, get funds!

Please submit the fully completed District Grant Application **not later than Friday, May 14, 2022.** You can access the applications on the Foundation tab of our website <u>rotarydistrict7210.org</u> or by clicking the appropriate one here: <u>Single Club Project</u> or <u>Large Scale Multi-Club Project</u>. The application needs to be completed **online** by the current club president. (*Sample applications are attached. Please do not submit a paper form*) In order for the application to be fully submitted, the current President-Elect must complete the proper attestation: <u>Single Club PE Attestation</u> **or** <u>Large Scale Multi-Club PE Attestation</u>. *For multi-club projects, a separate PE Attestation must be signed by all clubs listed on the primary application*.

Please note the following regarding the District Grant application and approval process:

- Provide ALL of the information required on the Rotary District 7210 District Grant Application.
- See District Grant Review Criteria (attached) for guidance on how Applications are evaluated.
- It is preferred that the Project address one or more of Rotary's seven Areas of Focus. Learn more: <u>https://www.rotary.org/en/our-causes</u>
- Your Club must have posted at least 13 Goals each for 2021-22 and 2022-23 on Rotary Club Central prior to submitting this District Grant Application (see attached instructions).
- A minimum total project amount of \$1,000 is strongly encouraged, with the Club or Clubs funding 50% or more of the total project amount.
- The District Grant Application must be for a single significant project or program, not for a collection of various dissimilar small projects or programs undertaken by the Club. A Club may <u>not</u> submit separate applications for more than one Project. Choose your most significant Project!
- The project must not begin before July 1, 2022 or when notice of final approval is given, whichever is later, and must be completed not later than June 30, 2023.
- The District Grant applications will be reviewed by the Grants Committee and a preliminary response will be provided to the Club on or about June 14, 2022, but final approval is contingent upon receipt of approval from The Rotary Foundation.
- All costs will be borne by the Club and only reimbursed by District funds, subject to approval and limitations by Rotary International, after satisfactory completion of the project, including:
 - 1. A Progress Report (on the District website) not later than May 1, 2023.
 - 2. A Final Report once the Project is completed (on the District website) with all required documentation not later than June 15, 2023. If your Project will be completed between June 15 and June 30, you must indicate this on your Progress Report and confirm the pending details by June 15.
 - 3. Confirmation of ALL Club expenditures for the project (bank statement or cancelled checks).
- The Club must adhere to appropriate stewardship measures and grant management practices, and is encouraged to complete the applicable Rotary Grant Management Seminar courses available on the Rotary Learning Center: <u>https://learn.rotary.org/members/pages/36/course-catalogs</u> Past District Grant process performance by the Club will be a consideration by the Committee on this and future grants. District Grant Review Criteria

Rotary Year 2022-23

A. Review Criteria: Large Scale Multi-Club Project

District 7210 wishes to encourage our Clubs to work collaboratively on larger and more impactful Projects, whether here in the Hudson Valley or beyond. If a proposed Project meets the following *Large Scale Multi-Club Project Criteria*, that Project will automatically be <u>awarded a 100-point score</u> on the Review Criteria (*see below*) and will <u>not</u> be subject to the "Available Funds Proportional Reduction" (provided that in doing so the resultant proportional reduction for all other Single Club Projects is not less than 50%):

- 1. The Project must be a collaboration between five or more D7210 Rotary Clubs.
- 2. The Project must be led by a "Primary Sponsor Club" which will be responsible for the coordination and submittal of all information required for the District Grant Application, Final Report, etc. for the duration of the Project.
- 3. If calculated, the Review Criteria for the Project and Primary Sponsor Club would be 70 points or greater.
- 4. The requested District Grant amount must be no less than \$5,000 (project scope \$10,000+), but not more than \$15,000 (project scope \$30,000+). *Subject to availability*

B. Review Criteria: Single Club Project

The following is a summary of the Review Criteria used in evaluating the quality of the Projects for which District Grants have been requested by a single D7210 Club (*or by multiple Clubs, but not qualifying for the above "Large Scale Multiple-Club Project Criteria"*). Points are calculated based upon these criteria, then the points are used to award funds in proportion of the total amount of approved District Grant application requested funds to the available District Designated Funds from Rotary International for this Rotary year (*"Available Funds Proportional Reduction"*), with the Projects with the higher points receiving proportionally more funds. If the calculated Total Preliminary Award Amount, after applying each Project's Review Criteria points score, exceeds the available Total District Designated Funds, Projects with calculated Preliminary Award Amounts which exceed that Club's average donation to The Rotary Foundation Annual Fund for the prior three years may have their Award Amounts reduced to be approximately that average donation amount.

1. Project Merit 40 points maximum

- a. The Project is directly related to one or more of Rotary's seven Areas of Focus. 15 points
- b. The Project responds to a significant and apparent need in the Project location. 15 points
- c. More than 100 people in need will benefit directly from this Project. 10 points

2. Club Participation 30 points maximum

- a. More than 33% of the Rotary Club's members directly participate in the Project. *10 points or* More than 67% of the Rotary Club's members directly participate in the Project. *20 points*
- b. More than 33% of the Club's sponsored Interact and/or Rotaract Club's members directly participate in the Project. *10 points*

3. Foundation Support 30 points maximum

- a. \$100/member to Annual Fund average & 100% participation, past 3 years. 5 points/year
- b. Club donation to the Annual Fund exceeded this requested Grant, past 3 years. 5 points/year

4. Bonus Points!

- a. The Grant Funds requested are 25% or less than the Total Project amount. 5 points
- b. More than 20% of the Club's members actively participate in Rotary Direct donations (5 *points*) *or m*ore than 40% of the Club's members actively participate in Rotary Direct donations (10 *points*) *or more* than 60% of the Club's members actively participate in Rotary Direct donations (15 *points*).
