Rotary Friendship Exchange 2021 is in the Works!










South Burlington Rotary Hosts Regional ZOOM Meeting with UVM President

2020-2021 District Grant Applications Reviewed

On May 16, 2020 the District Grant Committee met and reviewed nearly twenty grant proposals from District clubs. These proposals sought District grants that are funded by District Designated Funds (DDF). DDF comes from the donations of District Rotarians to The Rotary Foundation's Annual Fund – SHARE.

At the end of every Rotary year, contributions directed to the Annual Fund-SHARE from all Rotary clubs in the District are divided between the World Fund and DDF. At the end of three years, our District can use DDF to pay for Foundation, club, and district projects. Districts may use up to half of their DDF to fund district grants. The remaining DDF may be used for global grants or donated to PolioPlus, the Rotary Peace Centers, or another district.

After thorough discussion and review, the Grant Committee voted to issue preliminary approval for the grants listed below, with final approval being subject to Rotary International's review:



We will be thanking District Governor Richard Fox for his leadership and inspiration during the 2019-20 Rotary year.

We will be thanking the outgoing 41 Club Presidents for their leadership and welcoming our new District Governor and the Club Presidents who will lead and inspire us through the most unusual of times.

In addition to these grants, the District Grant Committee approved the commitment of \$15,000 to support a Global Grant sponsored by Rotary District 7870 (Southern VT and Southern NH) as part of its efforts to supply food to its region. It has agreed to devote a portion of our donation to provide food assistance in Quebec as well.

Finally, the District Grant Committee interviewed two candidates for the District's 2020-2021 Alonzo Malouin Teacher Scholarship: a music teacher from Hanover (NH) High School and an English teacher at Newfound Memorial Middle School. Both candidates were exceptional, resulting in each candidate receiving a \$2,500 scholarship with which to further their professional education.

2020-2021 District Representatives Selected, 2022-2023 District Governor Confirmed
